In an effort to consolidate our neighborhood trash day, trustee Brent Walls got quotes from the three local companies. Rumpke offered the best deal: a monthly rate of \$16/month.

From that base amount, you can rent a **wheeling tote** for an additional **\$1.50/month.** This is the big, brown wheeler that some people already have.

You may also choose **curbside recycling** for **\$4.00/month.** Rumpke has co-mingled recycling and provides a red bin to take to the curb. Allowable items are corrugated boxes, white ledger paper, folder, mail, envelopes, newspaper/magazines, computer paper, aluminum cans, and plastic bottles #1 and #2.)

Rumpke has offered our neighborhood a discount with at least 80 people. About 40 people already had Rumpke, and 40 others were willing to switch, so we are good to go.



If you are already a Rumpke customer, Rumpke will be sending you something in the mail soon. The start date will be **December 15.** Trash pick-up will be Mondays, Recycling pick-up will be on Friday.

If you have already indicated that you want to switch to Rumpke, Brent Walls has sent your name to Rumpke, and you should receive information from them soon. If you want to switch, contact Brent at bwalls@aigohio.com.
